Treatment of Impulse and Obsessive Disorders (TIOD)

Don't Step On a Crack!

ACAP's TIOD course presents a unique forum for individuals curious about how evolved depth theory and technique may provide more effective tools for understanding and working with TIOD. The same is done for other conditions in the full 4 courses of [ACAP's One Year Program](#). This brief series, elements of which can be taken in any order, offers an opportunity to sample the tools and ideas presented, and to decide if further study in this area is of interest.

The "Treatment of Impulse and Obsessive Disorders" course meets on six dates, and a clinical diagnostic category is discussed each week. Addictions, obsessive compulsive disorder, intermittent explosive disorder, and other disorders of impulse will be explored.

- The course prepares *clinicians* to work psychodynamically, at a new depth, with a wide range of presenting symptoms and offers perspectives from other mental health disciplines.
- The course provides a useful bridge for *educators, managers, and parents* for decoding what makes people with these symptom patterns behave as they do, and describes tools for putting that understanding into action in relationships in clinical practice and other life venues.
- In the course, recognition of personality dynamics, early resistances, and transference and countertransference issues facilitates a depth of understanding and possibility of promoting a working alliance whether with patients, colleagues, students, or family members.

One Year Program

Participants often report they have an intuitive sense of what people are really saying, but would like to enhance that and learn tools to put it to use in a variety of settings.

The One Year Program provides 4 six-week courses that can be taken in any order. Explore while you can earn 10-40 CE credits and enjoy lively, experiential group discussions.
