The Academy of Applied Psychoanalysis (ACAP) supports success at ACAP and the Boston Graduate School of Psychoanalysis, New Jersey (BGSP-NJ) by inviting students to apply for a range of scholarships. ACAP offers a variety of scholarships to assist students who have educational financial needs. All matriculated students and new students at ACAP and BGSP-NJ with a financial need are encouraged to apply.

### **Scholarship Descriptions:**

#### Bilingual Scholars Award

The Bilingual Scholarship, established in 2024 by Jeffrey Rosenberg, Esq., an ACAP trustee, is awarded to a new bilingual or multilingual student. This new scholarship, created to help meet the mental health needs of multilingual patients and is focused on attracting bilingual students interested in a mental health career.

#### Next Gen Scholarship


Established by a small group of loyal donors, the scholarship supports eligible incoming students. The scholarship is designed to lower financial barriers for students who will serve as the next generation of mental health professionals. Recognizing the growing need for psychoanalysts, and acknowledging the rising costs for psychoanalytic training, this scholarship's goal is to increase access for those seeking a career in mental health.

#### Gordon Ashworth Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of her husband by Dr. Judy Ashworth, the annual scholarship is awarded to an eligible student pursuing psychoanalytic study at the master's or post-graduate level. Inspired by the mission of ACAP, Mr. Ashworth was a treasured member of the ACAP community.

### Sandra L. Newman Memorial Scholarship

The Sandra L. Newman Memorial Scholarship, established by the Newman family, is awarded to an eligible student pursuing psychoanalytic study at the master's or post-graduate level. During her lifetime, Ms. Newman was a friend of ACAP and served as an advocate for others, with a particular focus on increasing access to mental health services and the training of mental health professionals.


